BASKETBALL

The Primary School Slam Series (previously Association Cup) is a 1 Day Basketball Tournament played across the State at local basketball facilities. This is a primary school basketball competition for years 3-6 students. The tournament caters for two divisions; All-Star and Future Star across both genders. The focus of the Champions Cup and School Slam Series is to promote basketball participation in a fun and safe environment, promote local sporting facilities and clubs and provide a pathway for students and teachers to participate in the sport.
